## PSAT/NMSQT

### **What is the PSAT/NMSQT?**

The PSAT is a two hour and forty-five-minute preliminary scholastic aptitude test that includes Math, Reading, and Writing/Language sections. The PSAT/NMSQT is the only test that can qualify students (11<sup>th</sup> graders) for the National Merit Scholarship program.

### **Who is eligible to take this test?**

Any freshman, sophomore or junior can register to take the PSAT. It is strongly recommended that anyone with plans to take the 4-year University route register to take the exam.

### **Why is it important to take the PSAT?**

The PSAT helps prepare you for future college entrance exams. It also places you on the radar of colleges across the country, helps determine your strengths and weaknesses and most importantly, allows juniors the opportunity to qualify for the National Merit Scholarship program (this is the only exam that can qualify you). The exam can open the door to countless college scholarship opportunities.

### **How do I register for the exam?**
