Students will be registering and paying for their exams through AP Test Service. Please register/pay: <https://aptestservice.com/> The 2019 AP Exams will be administered over two weeks in May: May 6 through 10 and May 13 through 17. AP Exams will be held at **St. Joseph's Church, 200 Carlton Avenue, Washington, NJ.** Students must report no later than 7:30 am for a morning exam and 11:30 for an afternoon exam. Students will need to provide their own transportation to and from our testing location. Students do not need to report to the high school before or after their exam.
