

2021 AP EXAM GENERAL INFORMATION

You need to be aware of the following information as you prepare for the 2021 AP Exams.

1. The test schedule (dates, times, and test location) is printed on the other side of this sheet. Please report to the testing room **15 minutes** before your test is scheduled to begin. 7:45 for morning exams and 11:45 for afternoon exams.
2. Please know that this schedule (date and time) is set by the College Board and cannot be changed.
3. Please check exam locations prior to your exam day. Most exams will take place in the Staff Development Room, UH Library, ITEP Room A619, the Childcare Room B401 and A409.
4. If you are registered to take the Psychology, Cal AB, US Gov't & Pol, Statistics or World History exams, testing usually takes place in multiple rooms - depending on the number of test takers. Your teacher will advise you which location you'll be testing in before the exam begins. You must test in your designated location because your student pack, answer sheet and test will be at that location.
5. If you are registered for two exams that are scheduled to take place at the same time, you must discuss the conflict with Mrs. Andrieux right away. The day and time is already determined and you'll be given this information at a later time.
6. If you are taking an afternoon exam at 12 noon and will miss lunch, you should eat lunch during 4th period and report to the test room by 11:50 a.m. Be aware that you won't be finished at 3:00 p.m. Please make arrangements for a ride and schedule your afternoon activities with this in mind.
7. Students will not be dismissed early from the exam session. All students must remain for the duration of the test. Please don't ask!!!
8. The day before your exam, notify your morning/afternoon teachers that you will be absent for AP testing and request your assignments. You are responsible for all makeup work.
9. You should bring several **#2 pencils**, several blue or black ink **pens**, an **eraser**, and an **approved calculator** (if you're taking a math or science test).
10. You may want to bring a sweater or sweatshirt (the Staff Development Room and Library are frequently cold) and a snack for the break.
11. You may not use a cell phone, pager, MP3 player, PDA or any other electronic or communication device in an exam room or during the break. ***Please do not bring any of these to the exam.*** Three years ago, 475 exams across the country were cancelled due to cell phone use during the exam or at break.
12. Please understand that your score will be cancelled if you do not follow the rules established by Educational Testing Services. (These rules will be announced at the beginning of each test.)
13. College Board policy states that upon completion of testing you may not listen to music, study, or read any other material except the testing material.
14. Come prepared having eaten breakfast and it's recommended that you bring a snack for break.
15. Please see Mrs. Andrieux, or Mrs. Stramara in the Counseling Office if you have any questions.
16. All AP scores will be accessible online in July. Learn more at apcentral.collegeboard.org. Remember your College Board account username, password and AP Number (or student ID number if you provide it on your AP answer sheet).
17. If you are scheduled to take a Keystone exam on the same day as an AP exam, you do not need to do both- AP exams are the priority. You should attend a Keystone exam make-up session.
18. A two-hour delay during Keystone exams do not apply to you if you have a morning AP exam scheduled on that day- you must still report at 7:45 AM.
