Priority registration for year-long and first semester AP classes is due Friday, October 29. The cost for each AP exam is \$96 if students register by this date. Students may still register for AP exams between October 30 through February 25, but the cost will then be \$136 per exam.

Registration for AP classes that begin second semester will be due Friday, February 25 and the cost is \$96 per exam.

Students will submit exam registration requests online through My AP but will also need to turn in a registration confirmation form along with payment in order to finalize their exam order.
