Exam Types

- **Hybrid Digital:** students complete multiple-choice questions and free-response questions in Bluebook, a digital platform that students download to their computers. Multiple choice responses are submitted electronically at the end of the exam period. Additionally, students handwrite their free-response answers in paper exam booklets that are returned for scoring.
- **Fully Digital:** Exams are completed using Bluebook, a digital platform that students download to their computers. All responses are submitted electronically at the end of the exam period.
 - *AP Chinese Language: exam is administered using UPrep-controlled devices with special digital software (not Bluebook)
 - *AP 2-D Art & Design: students upload their work to a special digital portfolio program (not Bluebook)
- **Paper:** Exams are completed using paper and pencil exam booklets and answer sheets, with some computer-based audio components for world language exams.
