Subject: 2026-2027 AP and Cambridge International Exam Funding Guidance

The Indiana Department of Education (IDOE) continues to support Indiana students through Advanced Placement (AP) and Cambridge International exam funding. The state's biennial budget provides funding to cover the exam fees for AP and Cambridge International exams taken by Indiana students in grades nine through 12 who are enrolled in an accredited public or non-public school. **A maximum of two exams per student, per year, may be funded.**

All Indiana students enrolled in an accredited public or non-public school in Indiana receive funding for a **maximum of two AP exams each school year**. Priority will be given to all AP exams listed in the table; however, as funding allows, AP exams *not listed in this table* may be funded for fee reduced students only.
